



Compact laminate

Properties

Compact laminate was originally created as facade cladding, providing a strong, sleek, and inclusive aesthetic. Made from 65% surplus wood from Norwegian sawmills, compact laminate bears a sustainable character. This material not only offers an elegant expression but also the freedom to design with colored surfaces. Its impressive durability makes it a choice with a lifespan of up to 50 years

Process

With sustainability in mind, our compact laminate (HPL) panels are made from 65% surplus wood from sawmills in Norway, certified according to FSC® and PEFC standards. HPL panels feature decorative paper on both sides, while the core consists of 50 layers of paper compressed with a fire-retardant and weather-resistant binder. This results in the formation of a robust 12mm panel. A compact material combining great strength and resistance to moisture and bacteria, ensuring long-term durability. UV and weather-resistant

Made from 65% surplus wood from Norwegian sawmills, HPL carries a sustainable character. The impressive durability of HPL has an estimated lifespan of up to 50 years
